

Bed Bug Incident Log for Guest Accommodation

Record physical evidence and actions without treating a bite report as proof or storing unnecessary guest and medical details.

Incident record

- ☐ Date, property, room or unit and reporting channel.
- ☐ Physical evidence found: specimen, spotting, shed skin or eggs.
- ☐ Close photograph with scale and wider room context.

Containment and access

- ☐ Record whether the room is occupied and which areas are accessible.
- ☐ Do not move furniture, linen or belongings between rooms before instructions.
- ☐ Record the person responsible for approved access and communication.

Assessment and follow-up

- ☐ Assessment date, rooms reviewed and evidence status.
- ☐ Agreed preparation, service or monitoring action.
- ☐ Follow-up date and any new physical evidence recorded separately.
